Repairs being looked into.

- 1. FIRE CHIEF: Chief Adams submitted his report for April, there were 10 fire and 23 medical. YTD 141.
- 2. Cemetery Sexton: Water to be turned on by memorial weekend. Not much feedback regarding ordinance as of yet.
- 3. Township Attorney: No report.
- 4. Commissioners Report: Rhonda Nye reported that the protective glass at the county building is in place. The title of the Deputy Administrator has been changed to HR/Finance manager Katie Heits has been hired. Follow up to the inhabitable premises request, the county health department can assist with investigation when it is a health threat such as septic issues. Otherwise, the townships will want to look into a dangerous buildings ordinance. Benzie County Road commission has acquired the Platte River School. There is a matrix starting for ideas for use of the stimulus money and one suggestion is sewer down the corridor. Nye stated that township and village officials could suggest other items to be added to the matrix for further consideration.
- 5. Zoning Administrator: 17 permits approved to date, 2 minor SLU pending. Planning Commission meeting June 3rd, will hear Crystal Lake Watershed updates.
